

The Jacobite Gathering

Saturday 19 September 2009



Be part of the first Great Jacobite Gathering Challenge taking place on Saturday 19 September 2009!

Teams will muster for 12 noon on Saturday at Culdaremore House, Fortingall for a wee dram and a taste of haggis before setting out on the stunningly spectacular ancient route up Glen Lyon and over to the finish at Boreland House, Killin.

You can enter with friends and colleagues and teams should have between two and four people. All walkers are encouraged to dress in traditional Jacobite or Red Coat attire and there will be several awards for best dressed categories. Soup, rolls and Haggis will be served at the start (Culdaremore House) from 11am onwards and the gathering will set off at 1pm prompt and head west up the ancient route south of the River Lyon towards Roromore and Balnahanaid before turning south up and over the hills and then west down to Boreland House, Killin.

The distance will be 18 miles and burning torches will be handed out after dark. There will be several themed refreshment stops en route serving hot drinks, soup and fine Jacobite cuisine. Walking on an average pace of 2.5 miles per hour will bring your team into the finish at Boreland House, Killin within eight hours including all stops, where a fine feast will be waiting. Spectacular fireworks, Jacobite re-enactment battles, ambushes and additional surprises will be part of the walk including massage, a sumptuous feast, and bar. Transport will be provided back to Culdaremore for those who require it.

There will be a £20 charge for additional guests attending the feast at the finish. Once we have received your application form and cheque we will send out a welcome note with more details on the event. We are asking each Jacobite to raise a minimum of £250 for the excellent causes and the funds raised will be distributed equally between The Sandpiper Trust and Mountain Rescue Teams after the event.
